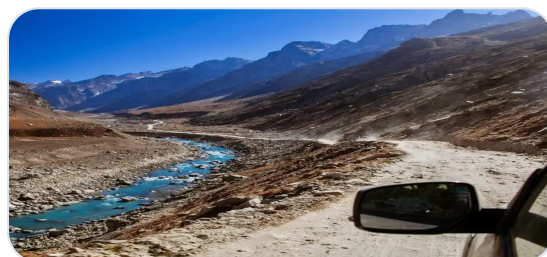

Detailed Itinerary

1 Day 1

Morning pickup from Manali and drive towards Jibhi via Aut Tunnel and Banjar Valley. Scenic Himalayan roads through pine forests and river valleys. Visit Jibhi Waterfall en route. Evening at leisure to acclimatise and relax in the village surroundings. Overnight: Jibhi

2 Day 2

Drive across Jalori Pass and descend towards Rampur. Continue along the Sutlej River, passing the Kinnaur Rock Gate and Karcham Dam. Experience narrow cliff roads typical of Kinnaur Valley. Overnight: Sangla

3 Day 3

Morning walk through Sangla Valley orchards. Visit Chitkul, the last village near the Indo-China border, and stop at Hindustan ka Aakhri Dhaba. Continue towards Kalpa and enjoy sunset views of the Kinner Kailash range. Overnight: Kalpa

4 Day 4

Gradual transition from green valleys to the cold desert landscape of Spiti. Stop at Khab to witness the confluence of Sutlej and Spiti rivers. Break at Nako Village and Lake before continuing to Tabo. Visit the historic Tabo Monastery. Overnight: Tab

5 Day 5

Morning excursion to Gue Village, known for its naturally preserved mummy. Continue along the Spiti River towards Kaza. Reach by afternoon and explore the local market or cafés. Overnight: Kaza

6 Day 6

Explore the high-altitude villages and monasteries around Kaza including Key Monastery, Langza Buddha Statue, Hikkim (world’s highest post office) and Komic (one of the highest motorable villages). Overnight: Kaza

7 Day 7

Drive via Losar, cross Chicham Bridge and ascend to Kunzum Pass. Visit Kunzum Mata Temple. Proceed towards Chandratal and walk from the last motorable point to the lake (subject to road and weather conditions). Overnight: Chandratal Camp

8 Day 8

Early start from Chandratal. Drive through Batal and Chhatru, stop at Chacha-Chachi Dhaba. Cross Atal Tunnel and reach Manali by evening. Tour concludes.

What's Included / Excluded

Inclusions

- Accommodation (7 Nights – Shared Basis)
- Participants will be accommodated on a twin / triple sharing basis at selected high-altitude suitable stays across the Spiti circuit:
- Jibhi – 1 Night
- Sangla – 1 Night
- Kalpa – 1 Night
- Tabo – 1 Night
- Kaza – 2 Night
- Chandratal Camps – 1 Night
- All properties are selected based on hygiene standards, operational reliability, and route feasibility.
- Single occupancy supplement available upon request (subject to availability).
- Meals
- Daily breakfast & dinner at respective stays
- Simple, hygienic, high-altitude suitable meals
- Dinner included at Chandratal camp
- Meals are planned to support long riding days and altitude adaptation.
- (Lunch is excluded to allow flexibility during riding hours.)
- Motorcycle & Fuel
- Well-maintained motorcycle (as per fixed departure allocation)
- Fuel for the complete 8-day Spiti circuit
- Motorcycles are inspected prior to departure and maintained for high-altitude performance.
- Riding Safety Support
- Standard ISI-certified helmet
- Basic riding gear support including:
 - – Riding jacket
 - – Knee guards
 - – Rain protection
- (Gloves and riding boots are not included.)
- Mechanical & Backup Support
- Basic mechanical assistance during the ride
- Access to route-based backup support vehicle

- Tool kit & puncture assistance (group level)
- Backup vehicle is designated for operational and safety support only.
- Route Execution & Coordination
- Complete sightseeing coverage as per fixed 7N/8D itinerary
- Group-based convoy riding model
- Daily ride briefing & terrain orientation
- End-to-end coordination from Manali to Manali
- Daily route planning based on weather and road conditions
- All required local permits as per route
- All operational and safety decisions on ground remain final and are taken in the interest of rider safety.

Exclusions

- Meals & Personal Expenditure
- The tour package does not include:
 - Lunch on travel days unless specifically mentioned
 - Snacks, beverages, bottled water
 - Laundry, room service, gratuities, tipping
 - Personal shopping and incidental expenses
- All personal expenditures are the sole responsibility of the participant.
- Entry Fees, Permits & Activity Charges
- Unless explicitly listed under inclusions, the following are excluded:
 - Monument, monastery, and attraction entry fees
 - Camera or videography charges
 - Village permits or conservation fees
 - Optional activity charges at any destination
- Participants are responsible for direct on-ground payments where applicable.
- Medical, Health & Emergency Evacuation Costs
- The package does not cover:
 - Hospitalization or medical treatment expenses
 - Ambulance or helicopter evacuation services
 - Oxygen consumption beyond emergency stabilization
 - Personal medicines and health requirements
- All high-altitude travel carries inherent medical risks. Participants accept full responsibility for personal medical preparedness.
- Travel Insurance
- Travel insurance is not included.
- Participants are strongly advised to secure comprehensive coverage including:
 - Medical and accident insurance
 - Emergency evacuation coverage
 - Trip delay or cancellation coverage
- TMA shall not be liable for uninsured losses.
- Force Majeure & Weather-Related Expenses
- In case of circumstances beyond operational control, including but not limited to:
 - Landslides

- Snowfall or road closures
- Political disturbances
- Natural calamities
- Any additional expenses arising due to:
 - Extra accommodation
 - Route deviations
 - Alternate transport arrangements
 - Extended stay
- shall be borne directly by participants.
- Operational decisions during such events remain at the discretion of the trip lead.
- Personal Delays & Non-Compliance
 - The following costs are excluded and payable by the participant:
 - Late arrival at reporting point
 - Missing group departure or movement
 - Voluntary early exit from the tour
 - Failure to comply with safety or operational instructions
 - The tour operates on a seat-based fixed departure model and cannot be customized for individual delays.
- Services Not Mentioned
 - Any service, facility, or charge not expressly listed under the “Inclusions” section shall be considered excluded.
- Bike Fixed Departure – Operational Exclusions
 - A. Refundable Security Deposit
 - A refundable security deposit is mandatory.
 - Amount varies depending on motorcycle model and season.
 - Refund is subject to post-ride inspection and clearance of damages, penalties, or unpaid dues.
 - B. Riding Gear & Personal Equipment
 - Unless explicitly mentioned under inclusions, the following are excluded:
 - Riding gloves
 - Riding boots
 - Personal riding accessories
 - Specialized high-altitude riding gear
 - Participants are responsible for appropriate riding preparedness.
 - C. Rider-Fault Mechanical Damage
 - Participants shall be financially liable for:
 - Mechanical damage resulting from falls, negligence, or misuse
 - Parts replacement beyond normal wear and tear
 - Damage caused due to reckless riding or improper handling
 - Assessment shall be determined by TMA’s authorized mechanic or operations lead.
 - D. Rule Violations & Operational Breach
 - Damage or penalties arising from:
 - Off-route riding
 - Ignoring safety briefings
 - Riding under influence of alcohol or prohibited substances
 - Non-compliance with convoy discipline
 - shall be chargeable to the participant.

- TMA reserves the right to remove any participant from the tour without refund in case of serious violation.
- Fixed Departure Policy Clarifications
- This is a seat-based group expedition, not a private customized tour.
- The backup vehicle is a support unit, not a comfort upgrade option.
- Access to locations such as Chandratol is strictly seasonal and road-dependent.
- On-ground safety and operational decisions by the trip lead are final and binding.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Is this 7N 8D Spiti tour suitable for first-time visitors?

Yes. This itinerary is designed with gradual altitude gain, balanced driving hours and proper acclimatisation, making it suitable for first-time as well as repeat Spiti travellers.

2. What is the starting and ending point of the tour?

The tour starts and ends in Manali. Pickup and drop are arranged in Manali as per the fixed departure schedule.

3. Which places are covered in this 7N 8D Spiti itinerary?

The itinerary covers Jibhi, Sangla, Chitkul, Kalpa, Tabo, Gue Village, Kaza, high-altitude villages (Key, Langza, Hikkim, Komic) and Chandratol Lake.

4. Is Chandratol Lake guaranteed in this itinerary?

Chandratol Lake is seasonal and road-dependent. Access is subject to weather, road conditions and administrative permissions. Safety-based decisions by the trip lead are final.

5. What type of accommodation is provided during the tour?

Accommodation is provided in clean hotels, guesthouses and camps on a twin or triple sharing basis. Properties are selected based on location, safety and availability in high-altitude regions.

6. What meals are included in the package?

Daily breakfast and dinner are included at all stays, including Chandratol camps. Meals are simple, hygienic and suitable for high-altitude travel.

7. What transport options are available for this tour?

This itinerary is available as a Bike Fixed Departure, Tempo Traveller, SUV or 4x4 tour. The route and experience remain the same; only the travel style changes.

8. How physically demanding is this Spiti tour?

The tour involves long drives, high altitude and limited facilities. Moderate fitness is recommended. No trekking experience is required, but travellers should be comfortable with basic mountain conditions.

9. Is medical support available during the tour?

Basic first-aid support and oxygen cylinders are carried during the tour. However, due to the remote nature of Spiti, travellers should carry personal medicines and consult a doctor before travelling.

10. Why should I book this Spiti tour with Travel Master Adventure?

Travel Master Adventure is a Manali-based Himalayan tour operator with strong on-ground control, experienced drivers and safety-first execution. The focus is on realistic planning, not rushed or over-promised itineraries.
