Detailed Itinerary

1 Day 1

Manali - Atal Tunnel - Kunzum Pass - Kaza

Pickup from Manali and drive towards Lahaul Valley via the Atal Tunnel. Cross Sissu and Chhatru before continuing towards Kunzum Pass. Descend into Spiti Valley and reach Kaza by evening. Overnight: Hotel / Guesthouse in Kaza Distance: ~200 km | 9-10 hours

2 Day 2

Kaza Local Sightseeing (Key - Kibber - Langza - Hikkim)

Explore the iconic high-altitude villages around Kaza. Visit Key Monastery, Kibber village, Langza (fossil village) and Hikkim, home to the world's highest post office. Overnight: Hotel / Guesthouse in Kaza Distance: ~40 km | 3-4 hours

3 Day 3

Kaza - Pin Valley - Mud Village - Kaza

Drive into Pin Valley National Park and visit Mud Village, known for its unique culture and landscapes. Return to Kaza by evening. Overnight: Hotel / Guesthouse in Kaza Distance: ~90 km | 4-5 hours

4 Day 4

Kaza - Tabo - Gyu - Kaza

After breakfast, drive towards Tabo and visit the ancient Tabo Monastery. Continue to Gyu village to see the naturally preserved Gyu Mummy. Return to Kaza in the evening. Overnight: Hotel / Guesthouse in Kaza Distance: ~95 km | 4-5 hours

6 Day 6

Kaza - Kunzum Pass - Chandratat

Leave Kaza after breakfast and drive towards Kunzum Pass. After crossing Kunzum, take the off-road stretch to Chandratat Lake. Spend the evening at leisure near the lake under star-lit skies. Overnight: Camps near Chandratat Distance: ~90 km | 4-5 hours

7 Day 7

Chandratat - Batal - Chhatru - Atal Tunnel - Manali

Early morning at Chandratat Lake followed by descent towards Batal. Continue through Chhatru and Sissu before crossing the Atal Tunnel to reach Manali by evening. Tour Ends

What's Included / Excluded

Inclusions

- Accommodation & Meals
- Accommodation (5 Nights – Shared Basis)
- Participants will be accommodated on a twin / triple sharing basis across selected stays in the Spiti region:
- Kaza / Tabo / nearby villages (as per route design & availability)
- All properties are chosen based on hygiene standards, altitude suitability, and operational reliability.
- Single occupancy supplement available on prior request (subject to availability).
- Daily Breakfast & Dinner
- Breakfast & dinner served at respective stays
- Simple, hygienic, high-altitude suitable meals
- Meals structured to support riding endurance and acclimatization
- Lunch is intentionally excluded to maintain flexibility during riding hours.
- Motorcycle & Fuel
- Well-maintained motorcycle allocated as per fixed departure category
- Fuel for the entire 5N/6D Spiti circuit
- All motorcycles undergo pre-departure inspection and are prepared for high-altitude terrain conditions.
- Riding Safety Support
- Standard ISI-certified helmet
- Basic riding gear support including:
 - – Riding jacket
 - – Knee guards
 - – Rain protection
- (Gloves and riding boots are not included and remain the rider's responsibility.)
- Mechanical & Backup Support
- Basic mechanical assistance during the ride
- Group-level tool kit and puncture support
- Access to route-based backup support vehicle
- The backup vehicle is deployed for:
 - Mechanical breakdown situations
 - Rider fatigue or emergency assistance
- It is strictly a support vehicle, not a private replacement or comfort upgrade.
- Route Execution & Operational Coordination
- Complete sightseeing coverage as per fixed 5N/6D itinerary
- Fixed departure execution with structured convoy movement
- Daily ride briefing & terrain orientation
- On-trip coordination & ground support from Manali to Manali
- Daily route planning aligned with weather and road conditions
- All necessary local permits as per route
- All operational and safety decisions on-ground remain final and are taken in the interest of rider safety and expedition integrity.

Exclusions

- Lunch & Personal Expenses

- The package does not include:
- Lunch during travel days
- Snacks, beverages, bottled water
- Laundry, room service, gratuities, tips
- Personal shopping or incidental expenses
- All personal expenditures remain the sole responsibility of the participant.
- Entry Fees & Activity Charges
- Unless explicitly included, the following are excluded:
- Entry fees at monasteries and attractions
- Camera or videography charges
- Village permits (if applicable at specific locations)
- Optional on-ground activity charges
- Participants are required to settle such charges directly at the respective sites.
- Medical & Emergency Evacuation
- The tour price does not cover:
- Oxygen support beyond emergency stabilization
- Hospitalization expenses
- Ambulance or helicopter rescue services
- Personal medicines and medical requirements
- High-altitude travel involves inherent risks. Participants must ensure personal medical preparedness before departure.
- Travel Insurance
- Travel insurance is not included.
- Participants are strongly advised to secure comprehensive coverage including:
- Medical and accident insurance
- Emergency evacuation coverage
- Trip delay or cancellation protection
- TMA shall not be liable for uninsured losses.
- Force Majeure / Weather-Related Costs
- In case of events beyond operational control, including but not limited to:
- Landslides
- Road closures
- Snowfall
- Political disturbances
- Natural calamities
- Any additional costs arising due to:
- Extended stay
- Extra accommodation
- Route deviation
- Alternate transportation
- shall be borne directly by the participants.
- Operational decisions during such events remain at the discretion of the trip lead.
- Personal Delays & Non-Compliance
- The following are excluded and payable by the participant:
- Late reporting at the meeting point

- Missing group movement or convoy departure
- Voluntary early departure from the tour
- Failure to follow safety or operational instructions
- This is a fixed departure, seat-based expedition and cannot be customized for individual timing changes.
- Services Not Mentioned
- Any service not explicitly mentioned under “Inclusions” shall be considered excluded.
- Additional Bike-Specific Exclusions
- Refundable Security Deposit
- A refundable security deposit is mandatory.
- The amount varies depending on motorcycle model and season.
- Refund is subject to post-ride inspection and clearance of damages or penalties.
- Riding Gear Not Included
- Unless specifically mentioned in inclusions, the following are excluded:
 - Riding gloves
 - Riding boots
 - Personal riding accessories
- Participants are responsible for appropriate riding preparedness.
 - Rider-Fault Mechanical Damage
- Participants shall be financially liable for:
 - Major mechanical repairs resulting from falls, negligence, or misuse
 - Parts replacement beyond normal wear and tear
 - Damage assessment shall be conducted by TMA’s authorized mechanic or operations team.
- Rule Violations & Operational Breach
 - Charges will apply for damage arising from:
 - Off-route riding
 - Ignoring safety briefings
 - Riding under the influence of alcohol or prohibited substances
 - TMA reserves the right to remove a participant from the expedition without refund in case of serious rule violations.
- Fixed Departure Clarifications
 - This is a seat-based group expedition — no private customization permitted.
 - The backup vehicle is designated for operational and safety support only.
 - Chandratal access is strictly seasonal and road-dependent.
 - On-ground safety and operational decisions by the trip lead are final and binding.

Frequently Asked Questions

1□ Is this a private tour or group tour?

This is a fixed departure, seat-based group tour. The itinerary, timings and halts are aligned for the entire group.

2□ Are rooms private or shared?

Accommodation is provided on twin or triple sharing basis. Single occupancy may be available at additional cost (subject to availability).

3□ Is fuel included in the bike tour?

Yes, fuel for the motorcycle is included in the fixed departure bike package.

4□ Is there a refundable security deposit for bikes?

Yes. A refundable security deposit is required for bike allocation. The amount depends on the motorcycle model and season.

5□ What happens in case of bike breakdown?

Basic mechanical support is provided. A backup support vehicle assists in case of breakdown or safety concerns, subject to route feasibility.

6□ Is Chandratal guaranteed?

No. Chandratal access depends on season, road conditions and safety feasibility. Final decision is taken on ground.

7□ What type of vehicle is used for 4-wheeler departures?

Seat-based departures operate in Tempo Traveller, SUV or 4x4 vehicles, depending on the batch and allocation.

8□ Is this tour suitable for beginners?

Yes, for 4-wheeler categories. Bike participants should have basic mountain riding experience.

9□ What meals are included?

Daily breakfast and dinner are included. Lunch and personal expenses are excluded.

What if weather affects the route?

Spiti is a high-altitude region. Route changes or adjustments may occur due to weather or road conditions. Safety decisions taken by the tour lead are final.

Policy & Terms

Spiti and Leh Bike Expedition Policy and Terms: These terms apply to both destinations and all fixed departure motorcycle expeditions operated by Travel Master Adventure. These are high-altitude Himalayan journeys, not regular leisure holidays. Weather, landslides, road diversions, water crossings, local restrictions, and operational adjustments may arise at any time. Therefore, the following payment, cancellation, health, damage, and operational policies apply strictly to every participant.

1. Payment Collection Schedule

Stage	Payment Amount	Timeline	Purpose

Stage 2: Confirmation	50% of Total Package Cost	45 Days Before Departure	Hotels, support vehicle, permits and crew allocation
Stage 3: Full Settlement	100% of Total Package Cost	21 Days Before Departure	Final room allocation, bike planning and operational clearance

Bookings made within 30 days of departure require 100% immediate payment for confirmation. Delayed payments may lead to automatic seat cancellation without prior notice.

2. Cancellation and Refund Policy

- **32 Days or More Before Departure:** Booking amount will be forfeited. Remaining balance, if any, will be refunded.
- **31 to 21 Days Before Departure:** 50% of the total trip cost will be charged.
- **20 Days or Less Before Departure:** 100% cancellation charge will apply. No refund and no date change will be permitted.
- **No Show:** 100% of the total amount will be forfeited.

All cancellation timelines are calculated from the official departure date in IST. These terms apply equally to Spiti departures and Leh departures.

3. Route, Weather and Operational Clauses

- **Spiti:** Routes may involve landslides, slush, broken mountain roads, water crossings, and rerouting based on safety and local conditions.
- **Leh:** Routes may involve high passes, weather closures, military or civil restrictions, local union rules, and permit-related adjustments.
- TMA reserves full rights to modify route flow, halt points, overnight stays, sightseeing order, support structure, or movement plan whenever required for safety and operational reasons.
- No refund or compensation shall be applicable for route changes, stay changes, administrative closures, permit delays, or safety-based execution changes.

4. Motorcycle Security and Damage Policy

- **Refundable Security Deposit:** ₹10,000 per motorcycle, payable before bike handover as per current operational procedure.
- Damage includes but is not limited to accidental falls, broken levers, clutch burn due to improper riding, bent rims, crash guard damage, broken lights, handlebar misalignment, or engine damage caused by negligent riding.
- Damage charges are calculated as **Original Spare Parts MRP + Labour Charges**.
- Normal wear and tear will be handled by TMA. Any damage caused by negligent riding, speeding, stunt riding, reckless use, or ignoring ride instructions remains the rider's responsibility.

5. Health and Altitude Responsibility (AMS Clause)

- Both Spiti and Leh are high-altitude destinations. Riders may travel between approximately 12,000 and 18,000 feet depending on route design.
- If a rider develops Acute Mountain Sickness (AMS), is advised by medical personnel not to continue, or voluntarily withdraws from the expedition, return transport, hotel, evacuation, or alternate logistics costs must be borne by the rider.
- No refund for unused services will be provided in such cases.
- TMA reserves the right to discontinue participation of any rider on medical, safety, or behaviour grounds.

6. Mandatory Riding Documentation

- An original valid Driving License with motorcycle-with-gear endorsement is mandatory for both Spiti and Leh expeditions.
- Government ID proof must also be carried in original form for permits, check-posts, and operational verification.
- Without valid original documents, the motorcycle will not be issued.
- Failure to provide valid documents will be treated as a last-minute cancellation and a 100% cancellation charge will apply.

7. Agreement Clause

By transferring the booking amount, the participant confirms full acceptance of these Spiti and Leh bike expedition policy and terms, including payment rules, cancellation structure, altitude responsibility, damage liability, and operational conditions, without exception.
