Detailed Itinerary

1 Day 1

Morning pickup from Manali and drive towards Jibhi via Aut Tunnel and Banjar Valley. Scenic Himalayan roads through pine forests and river valleys. Visit Jibhi Waterfall en route. Evening at leisure to acclimatise and relax in the village surroundings. Overnight: Jibhi

2 Day 2

Drive across Jalori Pass and descend towards Rampur. Continue along the Sutlej River, passing the Kinnaur Rock Gate and Karcham Dam. Experience narrow cliff roads typical of Kinnaur Valley. Overnight: Sangla

3 Day 3

Morning walk through Sangla Valley orchards. Visit Chitkul, the last village near the Indo-China border, and stop at Hindustan ka Aakhri Dhaba. Continue towards Kalpa and enjoy sunset views of the Kinner Kailash range. Overnight: Kalpa

4 Day 4

Gradual transition from green valleys to the cold desert landscape of Spiti. Stop at Khab to witness the confluence of Sutlej and Spiti rivers. Break at Nako Village and Lake before continuing to Tabo. Visit the historic Tabo Monastery. Overnight: Tabo

5 Day 5

Morning excursion to Gue Village, known for its naturally preserved mummy. Continue along the Spiti River towards Kaza. Reach by afternoon and explore the local market or cafés. Overnight: Kaza

6 Day 6

Explore the high-altitude villages and monasteries around Kaza including Key Monastery, Langza Buddha Statue, Hikkim (world's highest post office) and Komic (one of the highest motorable villages). Overnight: Kaza

7 Day 7

Drive via Losar, cross Chicham Bridge and ascend to Kunzum Pass. Visit Kunzum Mata Temple. Proceed towards Chandratul and walk from the last motorable point to the lake (subject to road and weather conditions). Overnight: Chandratul Camp

8 Day 8

Early start from Chandratul. Drive through Batal and Chhatru, stop at Chacha-Chachi Dhaba. Cross Atal Tunnel and reach Manali by evening. Tour concludes.

What's Included / Excluded

Inclusions

- Accommodation (7 Nights - Shared Basis)
- Participants will be accommodated on a twin / triple sharing basis at selected high-altitude suitable stays across the complete Spiti circuit:
 - Jibhi - 1 Night
 - Sangla - 1 Night
 - Kalpa - 1 Night
 - Tabo - 1 Night
 - Kaza - 2 Nights
 - Chandratat Camps - 1 Night (seasonal & road-dependent)
- All properties are selected based on hygiene standards, operational reliability and route feasibility.
- Single occupancy supplement available upon request (subject to availability).
- Meals
 - Daily breakfast and dinner at respective stays
 - Simple, hygienic, high-altitude suitable meals
 - Dinner included at Chandratat camp (when operational)

- Meals are structured to support long mountain travel days and altitude adaptation.
- (Lunch is intentionally excluded to allow flexibility during road movement.)
- Vehicle & Travel Format (SUV / Tempo Traveller)
- Private SUV or Tempo Traveller allocated as per group size
- Professional local mountain driver for entire 7N/8D circuit
- Vehicle fuel for complete Spiti route included
- Driver allowance, tolls and parking included
- Vehicles are inspected prior to departure and selected based on terrain practicality and passenger comfort.
- 4x4 vehicles may be deployed depending on road condition, season or terrain requirements.
- Vehicle selection is based on real-time operational assessment.
- Mechanical & Route Support
- Driver-level troubleshooting coordination
- Access to operational backup support vehicle (when required)
- On-route coordination support for remote stretches
- The backup vehicle is designated strictly for operational and safety support, not as a private replacement or comfort upgrade.
- Route Execution & Coordination
- Complete sightseeing coverage as per structured 7N/8D itinerary
- Fixed departure timing structure (for group departures)
- Daily route planning based on weather and road updates
- End-to-end coordination from Manali to Manali
- All required local permits as per route
- All operational and safety decisions taken on ground remain final and are made in the interest of traveller safety and route integrity.

Exclusions

- Meals & Personal Expenditure
- The tour package does not include:
 - Lunch on travel days unless specifically mentioned
 - Snacks, beverages and bottled water
 - Laundry, room service, gratuities or tipping
 - Personal shopping and incidental expenses
- All personal expenditures remain the sole responsibility of the participant.
- Entry Fees, Permits & Activity Charges
 - Unless explicitly listed under "Inclusions", the following are excluded:
 - Entry fees at monasteries, monuments and attractions
 - Camera or videography charges
 - Village permits or conservation fees (if applicable)
 - Optional activity charges at any destination
 - Participants are required to settle such charges directly at the respective locations.
- Medical, Health & Emergency Evacuation Costs
 - The package does not cover:
 - Hospitalization or medical treatment expenses
 - Ambulance or helicopter evacuation services
 - Oxygen consumption beyond emergency stabilization

- Personal medicines or pre-existing medical conditions
- High-altitude Himalayan travel involves inherent risks. Participants accept full responsibility for their medical preparedness prior to departure.
- Travel Insurance
- Travel insurance is not included in the package.
- Participants are strongly advised to secure comprehensive coverage including:
 - Medical and accident insurance
 - Emergency evacuation coverage
 - Trip delay or cancellation protection
- Travel Master Adventure shall not be liable for uninsured losses.
- Force Majeure & Weather-Related Expenses
- In circumstances beyond operational control, including but not limited to:
 - Landslides
 - Snowfall or road closures
 - Political disturbances
 - Natural calamities
- Any additional costs arising due to:
 - Extended stay
 - Extra accommodation
 - Route deviations
 - Alternate transportation arrangements
- shall be borne directly by the participants.
- All operational decisions during such events remain at the discretion of the trip lead and ground operations team.
- Personal Delays & Non-Compliance
- The following are excluded and payable by the participant:
 - Late arrival at reporting point
 - Missing group departure or scheduled movement
 - Voluntary early exit from the tour
 - Failure to comply with safety or operational instructions
- This tour operates on a seat-based fixed departure model and cannot be modified for individual delays or personal schedule changes.
- Vehicle & Operational Responsibility (SUV / Tempo Format)
- Participants shall be financially liable for:
 - Damage caused to vehicle interiors due to negligence
 - Loss or damage to vehicle equipment
 - Any penalty imposed due to participant misconduct
- The assigned vehicle (SUV / Tempo Traveller / 4x4) is selected based on operational feasibility and terrain suitability.
- Vehicle replacement due to passenger comfort preference is not guaranteed.
- Fixed Departure Policy Clarifications
- This is a structured group departure, not a private customizable tour.
- The support vehicle (if deployed) is strictly for operational and safety coordination.
- Access to locations such as Chandratol is seasonal and road-dependent.
- All on-ground operational and safety decisions taken by the trip lead are final and binding.

Frequently Asked Questions

1□ Is the Spiti circuit via Kinnaur safe for families?

Yes, the Spiti circuit via Kinnaur is considered safer for altitude adaptation because the ascent is gradual. However, it remains a high-altitude Himalayan route, so basic medical fitness is essential.

2□ Which vehicle is best for this Spiti circuit?

The itinerary can be executed in: • SUV • Tempo Traveller • 4x4 (depending on terrain & season) Vehicle selection depends on group size, departure format and road conditions at the time of travel.

3□ Is Chandratal Lake included in this itinerary?

Yes, Chandratal is included when road and weather conditions permit. Access is strictly seasonal and depends on Kunzum Pass and approach road status.

4□ What is the best time to do the Spiti circuit via Kinnaur?

The most stable season is typically May to October. However, early and late season departures depend on road clearance and weather updates.

5□ Is this a private tour or fixed departure?

Both formats are available: • Seat-based fixed departure (group format) • Private SUV format (custom departure) Timings and execution differ based on format.

6□ Are oxygen cylinders provided during the trip?

Emergency oxygen support is available for stabilization purposes. However, participants must carry personal medicines and ensure medical preparedness before travel.

7□ How difficult are the roads on the Spiti circuit?

The terrain includes narrow mountain roads, rough patches, high-altitude passes and remote stretches. Experienced local mountain drivers handle vehicle navigation throughout the journey.

8□ What type of accommodation is provided?

Accommodation includes selected guesthouses, boutique stays and seasonal camps at Chandratal. All stays are chosen based on hygiene, altitude suitability and operational reliability.
